Don't forget it is a Bank Holiday on Monday (3rd of May), so school will be closed.



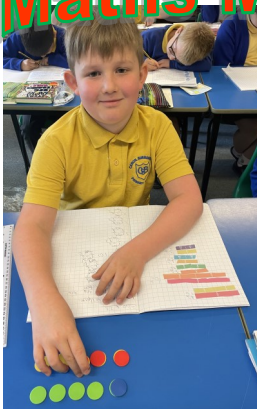
The theme for this year's Arts Week is Reduce, Reuse, Recycle.

This week we have shown our Christian value of **Peace**

Jesus said: "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God." (Matthew 5:9). Peace-making actions can range from helping to resolve conflict to creating space for stillness. Peace, in the sense of total well-being, is God's intention for the whole of creation, and is a promise that awaits ultimate fulfilment.

On the 15th of May, The Royal British Legion will celebrate 100 years since its formation. The charity is at the heart of a national network that supports our Armed Forces community. Google Classroom

Please can parents make sure they check on Google classroom for any homework that is set for their child(ren), especially if they do not bring their homework book home. Many classes in school are regularly setting their homework on Google classroom.

As the weather starts to improve, please can you ensure your child has sun cream applied before they come to school. If your child is able to apply their own sun cream, they may bring it to school in a labelled bottle, but staff will not be able to apply the sun cream for them.



Please can you also ensure that you child has a labelled water bottle, so they can remain hydrated, particularly in warmer weather and a hat with their name in, to provide extra sun protection.

From the Office

Please could all parents/carers make sure that they are checking emails regularly and check that notifications are turned on, on their SchoolComms App. We are sending out lots of electronic communication at the moment and we don't want you to miss any important messages.

Alternative pick up arrangements

Please can parents/carers ensure that they let the office know if someone else is collecting their child, where possible by 2pm each day. This ensures that those who are sending children out are aware that they are going with another adult. Please can you also have a password ready, so we can ensure the identity of the person on arrival this will be recorded for future use.

Nursery Places

Parents of children currently attending Canon Burrows, who have a younger sibling approaching 3 years of age, can apply for a nursery place. Please contact the office for more information.

Children's belongings

Please can parents/carers ensure their child(ren) have everything they need at the very start of the school day in order to avoid multiple visits from parents/carers and other family members/friends to the gate. This will reduce the number of objects being passed from person to person and help reduce the risk of spread of infection.

Appointments during the school day.

Please can we remind parents/carers that wherever possible non-emergency appointments should be booked out of school hours to reduce disruption and lost learning time.

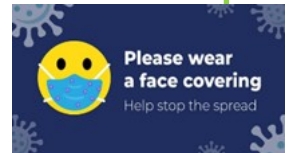
Covid Guidance

Please do not send children into school if they are waiting for Covid-19 test results or if they have symptoms of Covid-19 (cough, temperature, loss of taste or smell); take them for Covid-19 PCR test. Please inform school if you have tested positive for Covid-19 or are waiting for test results.

School drop off & pick up

Thank you for your continued patience and support with regards to dropping off & collecting children from school. Please can you ensure you are following the guidance below.

- Please adhere strictly to your drop off & collection times and do not loiter outside the gates.
- Maintain social distancing at all times during drop off & pick up
- We kindly ask that parents/carers wear face coverings when they drop off & pick up their children
- Please do not park on the school or vets car park when dropping off or collecting your children.



Issues around not following government guidance:

As you will appreciate staff and parents who send their children to school are trusting that everyone else coming into school are following the strict guidance around national restrictions and not mixing with other households. If there is evidence on social media that these restrictions are being broken or if the children are telling us they are visiting family and friends, attending birthday parties or going for tea at someone else's house outside of their bubble, then obviously staff and other parents are going to be genuinely concerned. Please do not be offended if you are asked about these concerns. We are purely trying to keep everyone as safe as they possibly can be. School may choose to ask that your child isolated for a period of 10 days if they have mixed with other bubbles.

Free rapid testing for all as COVID restrictions eased

All adults in Tameside are now able to access free, regular, rapid coronavirus testing as part of the easing of COVID restrictions.

Alongside the rollout of the vaccine, regular testing of those without symptoms is an essential part of the easing of restrictions as it will help to quickly suppress the spread of COVID and break the chain of transmission. The rapid lateral flow tests are quick, easy and give a result within half an hour.

To help best protect the community it's recommended that everyone gets tested twice a week. If you receive a positive result you should isolate and book a confirmatory PCR test.

Remember, these test are only for those who are asymptomatic (do not have any symptoms). If you have symptoms, you need to have a PCR test.

The DFE advise that primary-aged pupils should only be tested if they are symptomatic, in which case their families should follow the guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection and book a PCR test for the child.
