Read five times a week — one of these five times must be with an adult. Each time you read, you must write in your reading diary with either a summary of the key events or your thoughts about what you have read. The adult you read with must write in your diary at least once per week.

Your reading diary needs to be in school every day for your teacher to see please.

We would really encourage you to read the weekends too – the more reading you do, the better!

Dear Parent / Guardian

We are pleased to announce that we have organised a clothes & shoe collection with Bag2School in order to raise money for our school fund.

Bag2School is the UK's leading textile recycler and fundraiser working with schools and since its inception in 2001 it has now paid out over £36 million.

As well as raising vitally needed funds for school it also helps the environment by helping to divert unwanted textiles away from landfill. A recent DEFRA report has shown that textile collection schemes are helping to reduce the volume of textiles discarded as municipal solid waste. However it is a fact that as a nation we still send 350,000 tonnes of textiles to landfill every year.

By getting involved in our **Bag2School** collection, you have an opportunity to sort through your cupboards and wardrobes and donate unwanted textiles — this can include adults' and children's clothes, shoes (tied together please), hats, belts, handbags and soft toys, (please refer to http://uk.bag2school.com/ for full details).
