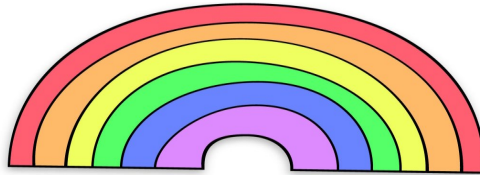

**MFL (Modern Foreign Languages):** Spanish

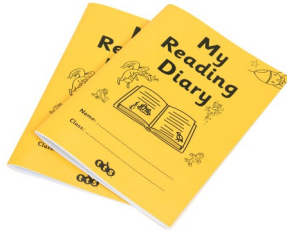

is to read regularly.

We know some of you may have read lots over the  
holidays and that some of you may be needing a good  
book to get you reading again.

Hopefully, the ideas on these pages will inspire you all  
to get lost in a good book!

### Why is reading important?

If you read for **1 minute a day**, you will see **8,000 words** a year.

If you read for **5 minutes a day**, you will see **282,000 words** a year.

If you read for **20 minutes a day**, you will see **1,800,000 words** a year!

Imagine the impact over a million new words would have on the rest of your learning!
