We have a new lunchtime craft club starting next Thursday 9th May run by Smashing Crafts Workshops.

The first block will be 5 weeks – 9^{th} , 16^{th} and 23^{rd} May, then when we return after half term it will continue on the 13^{th} and 20^{th} June. The cost is £3 per session, £15 for the block.

The second block will be 4 weeks –27th June, 4th, 11th and 18th July. The cost is £3 per session, £12 for the block.

There are 20 spaces for each club, 10 for KS1 children and 10 for KS2 children.

There will also be a new football club starting next Wednesday 8th May for Years 4, 5 & 6 run by Stalybridge Celtic. This will run for 9 weeks.

There are still spaces available on these new clubs as well as other clubs, such as KS2 multimedia club on Thursdays after school. Check the app for details of all the clubs that still have places available.

Alternative payment method for clubs/trips



If you are having problems paying for a club/trips via the School Gateway app, it is possible to make a payment at any PayPoint store.

To do this you will need to phone or text the school office with your child's name and details of the club/trip you would like to pay for. The office staff will then be able to issue a voucher for you to collect and take to a PayPoint store to pay.

Please note that PayPoint payments are not credited to school immediately, unlike the School Gateway app, but by 11am the following working day. If you are making an urgent payment, please ensure you do this with adequate time for the payment to go through.

Dear Parents/carers,

We have introduced a wellbeing program to all year groups at school called myHappymind.

myHappymind is all based around helping children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves!

myHappymind is delivered in schools by class teachers through a series of interactive lessons and then the children apply what they have learnt throughout the day. To further embed this learning and ensure that you are able to engage in these topics with your child, myHappymind has developed 2 incredible resources for parents which, you can access for free.

1) The myHappymind App - myHappymind have developed an App for parents to download for free. It is available on both Google Play and on the Apple store. If you search for myHappymind you will find it. The App allows children to continue to practice some of the habits they have developed at school e.g. happy breathing and also to complete quizzes based on what they have learnt through the myHappymind curriculum. You will be able to access this once your child has completed the first module in school.

2) The parent portal - this is a website just for parents of myHappymind schools and it contains lots of information about the curriculum as well as conversation prompts that you can use to help get the conversation about wellbeing and mental health going at home.
