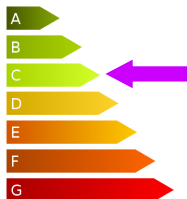
Year 2 have had a Mexican day

We have received our new Display Energy Certificate and have, once again, done a great job in saving energy over the last twelve months.

Our new Energy Performance Operational Rating is 59. (100 would be typical) This means we are for the first time in the green band. It is a drop of 21 points from last year, and last year we dropped 14 points from 2017, so a drop of 35 points over two years. This also means we are producing much less CO<sub>2</sub>, our carbon footprint has reduced by 10 tons this year. Electricity use is still higher than we would like, so we do need to ensure we remember to switch off at all times.
