1:1 Reading Volunteers...could you be interested?



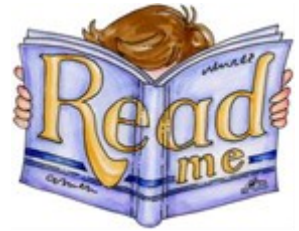
Thank-you to all our wonderful volunteers who worked with our children last year and those who have begun volunteering this year.
