During the time we are closed we will be communicating via email, the school website and twitter. Don't forget to check these regularly, if you have not followed us on twitter now may be a good time.


Work will be set for the children while they are at home, with a new learning project being uploaded to each year group's page in the new 'home learning' section of the school website each Friday at 4pm.
