Expanded noun phrases:

An **expanded noun phrase** is a **phrase** made up of a **noun** and at least one adjective.

If one or more adjectives are listed to describe the **noun**, a comma should be added to separate the sentence.

Article adjective noun.

The beautiful tiger.
