


# Year 2 Learning Project Week 9 - Ascension Day

This week's learning project looks a little bit different; that is because this Thursday (21st May) is an important day in the Christian calendar - Ascension Day.

Ascension Day marks 40 days since Jesus rose on Easter Sunday and is the day Jesus permanently rose to Heaven to be with God.

Can you create a piece or art — a picture or sculpture — that shows something you are grateful for in God's world.

Can you take a photograph to show 'Where is God?' for the Spirited Arts Competition?

Can you create a dance that shows how Jesus ascended to heaven?

Go for a walk and find the most amazing thing that God created.
