


## EYFS Learning Project Week 9- Ascension Day

Ascension Day marks 40 days since Jesus rose on Easter Sunday and is the day Jesus permanently rose to Heaven to be with God. Discuss what happened after Jesus died and rose again at Easter. Use the Twinkl hotspot presentations to find out more. The <u>first one</u> shows Ascension Day when Jesus went to heaven and the <u>second one</u> shows what Christians do on Ascension Day today. To use these you will need to set up a Twinkl account using the details at the bottom of this document.

<u>Writing</u> Draw a picture of your favourite things in God's world. Can you add labels to your drawings?
