

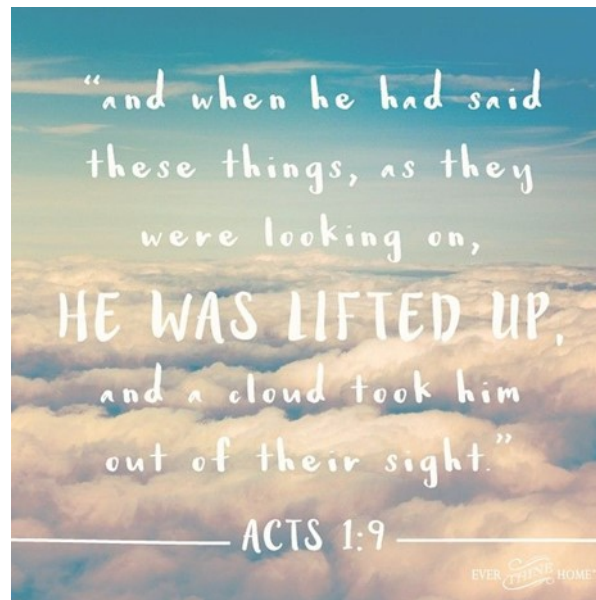


Year 1 Learning Project Week 9 - Ascension Day

This week's learning project looks a little bit different; that is because this Thursday (21st May) is an important day in the Christian calendar - Ascension Day.

Ascension Day marks 40 days since Jesus rose on Easter Sunday and is the day Jesus permanently rose to Heaven to be with God.

Reading

Read the information about Ascension Day using the Power Point on your home learning page. Discuss what happened after Jesus died and rose again at Easter.

Read the Ascension Day information sheet together. Can you use the information to answer the questions about Ascension Day? The answers are there to help you too.

Writing

Write a thank you letter to your God to thank him for all of the amazing things we have in our world.

What will you say thank you for?

Remember to include: finger spaces, capital letters, full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and to apply your phonics in your spellings.

Wondering

Talk about . . .

- your favourite part of God's world and why they are important to you.
- why it is important that we look after God's world and how we can do that.
- what you would change about God's world.
- How could you make God's world even better?

Create

Can you draw or paint a picture of what you think heaven might be like?

Can you create a piece of art – a picture or sculpture – that shows something you are grateful for in God's world.

Can you take a photograph to show 'Where is God?' for the Spirited Arts Competition?

Be Active:

Can you create a dance that shows how Jesus ascended to heaven?

Go for a walk and find the most amazing thing that God created.

Recommendation at least 2 hours of exercise a week.
