Reception

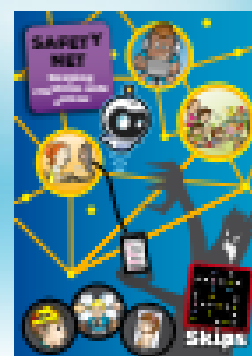
After reading Oliver's Fruit Salad the Reception children enjoyed making their own fruit skewers.

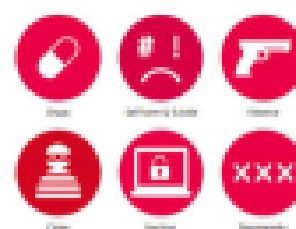
