Out of School Clubs

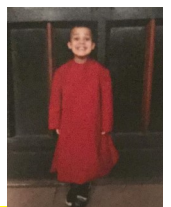
Please note that there is NO drama club next Thursday May 2nd. Can parents/carers please ensure children are picked up from school at 3.10pm

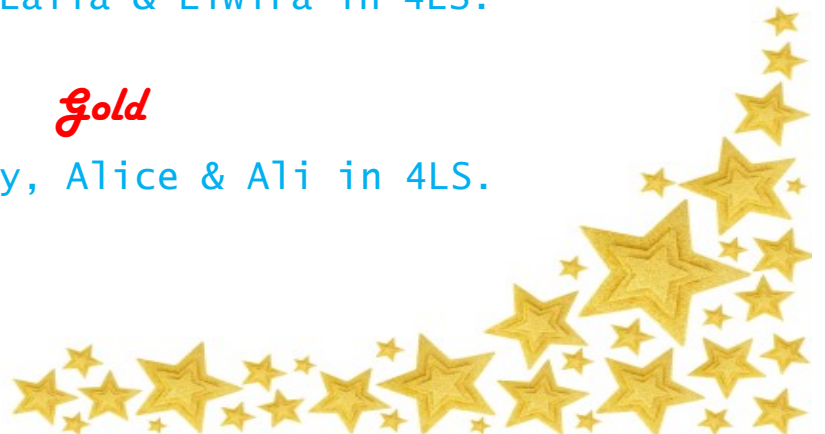

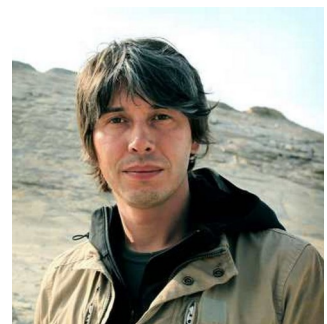
ARTS WEEK 2019

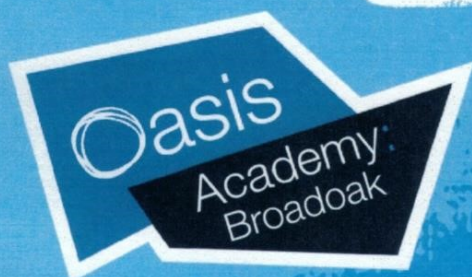
MANCHESTER
